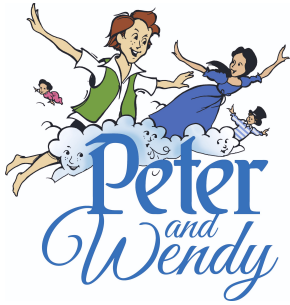

Most people don't get to see what happens before the curtain rises. This workshop explains how the process of role-play helps to increase communication skills and teaches constructive group dynamics.			
Improv	Thursday August 3, 2017	2:45 – 3:30 pm	Grade Level 1-5
Participation and teamwork are emphasized as the students learn to act without a script. This workshop is for all skill levels from beginners to more experienced performers.

The primary goal of MCT is the development of life skills in children through participation in the performing arts. Within each MCT cast, girls and boys are equal; the disabled become able; the shy experiment with bravery; the slow are rehearsed to perfection; and the gifted become part of the whole. MCT provides a unique opportunity to learn the lessons of group dynamics while excelling as an individual – a lesson from art that carries into life.
