ALL K-1 LEAGUE GAMES ARE PLAYED ON THE EAST FIELDS (BY THE BLUE SOCCER SHED).

Girls play on the south K1 field.

K1 Boys play on the north K1 field.

No players will be allowed in the semicircle area in front of the goal.

There will be no extra period in the event of a tie. Games will be played at Westbrook soccer fields.

Kindergarten & 1st grade Rules

1. **First team** listed on the schedule wears **white jerseys** and the **second team** listed will wear **purple jerseys**.
2. We will use a #3 size ball for junior (K-1) league.
3. **All players must wear shin guards.** No steel cleats or hard boots are permitted.
4. **Socks must be worn on TOP of the shin guards!**
5. Each child is entitled to play at least one-half of a game (two quarters).
6. Substitutions can be made at any dead ball but encouraged at quarter breaks.
7. K-1 games consist of (4) eight-minute quarters with a five-minute break at the half. There is no extra period for a tie game.
8. A coin toss will determine team possession at the start of each game. The team starting the game with the ball also starts the 3rd quarter with the ball. The team starting the 2nd half with the ball also has possession to start the 4th quarter.
9. A direct free kick will be awarded for the following violations; kicking an opponent; charging an opponent; striking an opponent; holding or pushing an opponent; carrying, striking, or propelling the ball with the hands. An indirect free kick is awarded for the following violations: intentionally obstructing play or an opponent, any unsportsmanlike conduct. A direct free kick may result in a score whereas an indirect free kick must first touch another player.
10. A ball completely crossing a sideline is put back into play by the team opposing that of the person who last touched the ball by using throw-in.
11. A ball crossing an end line is put back into play by a goal kick if the attacking team last touched it and by a corner kick if the defensive team last touched it.
12. All games will be held at Westbrook Park.
13. Please remember that the drive to the south of the fields is one way and there is parking available to the area east of the fields.
14. **Rain cancellation policy.** We cancel games due to:
 - a. (1) lightning, driving rain, or other conditions making play dangerous or impractical; or
 - b. (2) ground so wet that play will damage the fields. We don't cancel merely because it's raining or snowing. Cancellation may occur at any time. We strongly advise that coaches and parents exchange cell phone numbers so that word of last-minute cancellations can be spread quickly.
